



## **HMCS Haida**

## For young learners (Grades 4 to 7)

- 1. What was the purpose of HMCS Haida and how many other tribal-class destroyers were built during the Second World War?
- 2. What was the Murmansk Run? Where did it take Allied ships?
- 3. Why were convoys important during the Second World War? Which nations were most heavily involved with convoy missions?
- 4. Imagine that you are a sailor on HMCS Haida on 28 April 1944 as HMCS Athabaskan was hit. From a sailor's perspective write a journal or diary entry (2-3 paragraphs) that describes the event. Include your thoughts, feelings, impressions, and any important historical information.

## For advanced learners (Grade 8 and up)

5. There was a considerable amount of art created depicting the sinking of HMCS Athabaskan. Research these paintings, drawings, and artist renditions of the event. Write a paragraph analyzing the paintings, making sure to discuss relevant themes and the historical importance of the works.
