## For young learners (Grades 4 to 7)

- 1. Where was Keeper born?
- 2. How did Keeper's career as an athlete help him as a dispatch carrier?
- 3. In 1899, Keeper was sent to a residential school. Where was this residential school and why were Indigenous children sent to such schools?
- 4. Keeper was both an athlete and a soldier. Draw a Venn-Diagram to demonstrate similarities and differences between these two professions keeping in mind physical and mental attributes.



## For advanced learners (Grade 8 and up)

- 5. Read the scholarly article, <u>The 107th "Timber Wolf" Battalion at Hill 70</u> (Canadian Military History Journal), by Steven Bell. Create a timeline of the creation and development of this battalion. Which battles were the 107<sup>th</sup> involved in?
- 6. Research the Battle of Cambrai. Describe the tactical and strategic plans for the battle and the outcome. Why did Keeper win a distinguished medal for his service there?
