## For young learners (Grades 4 to 7)

- 1. Which military honours were the Louie Brothers awarded?
- 2. Wee Tan was a runner in France and Belgium. What were his duties and why were they important?
- 3. Why were Chinese Canadians exempt from conscription during the First World War?
- 4. What did Wee Hong mail to Prime Minister Mackenzie King? Why did he do this? What does this suggest about Hong's character?

## For advanced learners (Grade 8 and up)

- 5. Research the 1923 Chinese Immigration Act. What was its purpose? Did it have a precedent? Write a paragraph commenting on the treatment of Chinese Canadians during the war and post-war years based on this document.
- 6. Imagine you are a Chinese Canadian in the 1920s. Write a response to the Chinese Immigration Act. State your thoughts and situate your response historically.
