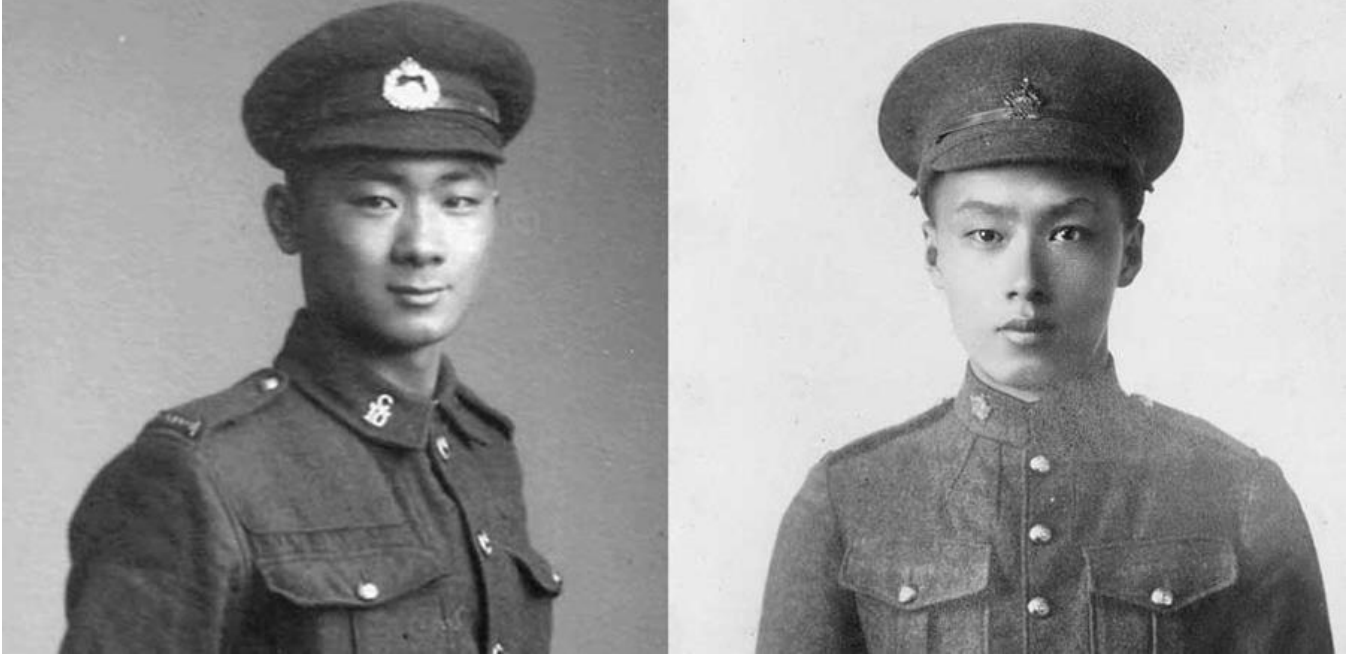

## The Louie Brothers

For young learners (Grades 4 to 7)

1. Which military honours were the Louie Brothers awarded?
2. Wee Tan was a runner in France and Belgium. What were his duties and why were they important?
3. Why were Chinese Canadians exempt from conscription during the First World War?
4. What did Wee Hong mail to Prime Minister Mackenzie King? Why did he do this? What does this suggest about Hong's character?

For advanced learners (Grade 8 and up)

5. Research the 1923 Chinese Immigration Act. What was its purpose? Did it have a precedent? Write a paragraph commenting on the treatment of Chinese Canadians during the war and post-war years based on this document.
6. Imagine you are a Chinese Canadian in the 1920s. Write a response to the Chinese Immigration Act. State your thoughts and situate your response historically.
