## **Tommy Prince**



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Read about Tommy Prince (https://valourcanada.ca/military-history-library/sgt-tommy-prince/) on Valour Canada's military history library online and answer the following:

### For young learners (Grades 4 to 7)

- 1. Tommy Prince was involved in which two wars? List the various units Prince was a part of during his military service.
- 2. While in France in 1944, Prince and his partner came across a group of Free French Partisans. Define the term "partisan" and describe their role in the war.
- 3. What is PTSD? Why is it important to pay attention to veterans' mental health?

### For advanced learners (Grade 8 and up)

- 4. Prince experienced discrimination upon his return to Canada following the Second World War. Corporal Pegahmagabow, mentioned in the article, experienced similar treatment following the First World War. Research both soldiers and create a Venndiagram displaying similarities and differences between them. Consider their lives, their military service, their pensions, and how they were treated following their respective wars.
- 5. Analyze the First Special Service Force (FSSF) card and Black Devils image shown in the article. The FSSF would leave these cards for their enemies to see. Is this a form of psychological warfare? If so, how? Were these methods effective in the Second World War?
