For young learners (Grades 4 to 7)

- 1. Léo Major was involved in which two major operations in the Second World War?
- 2. How many young Canadians sacrificed their lives to liberate the Netherlands?
- 3. Summarize Léo Major's actions in Zwolle. What characteristics did he exemplify?
- In your opinion provide two reasons why many Canadians may have not heard about Léo Major.

For advanced learners (Grade 8 and up)



- 5. What was the Dutch underground? Did other Nazi occupied countries have resistance groups? Create a table that shows these resistance groups, their respective countries, the actions they took to resist, and whether they had any impact on the Nazi occupiers.
- Read the linked article, <u>Leo Major, the One-Eyed, One-Man Army</u>. Write a one-page biography about Major's contributions to the Second World War and the Korean War.
- 7. Research the ways in which the Netherlands (its people and its government) pays respect, honours, and commemorates the sacrifices of Canadian soldiers during the Second World War. Create a PowerPoint or Prezi presentation to share your findings with your class.
