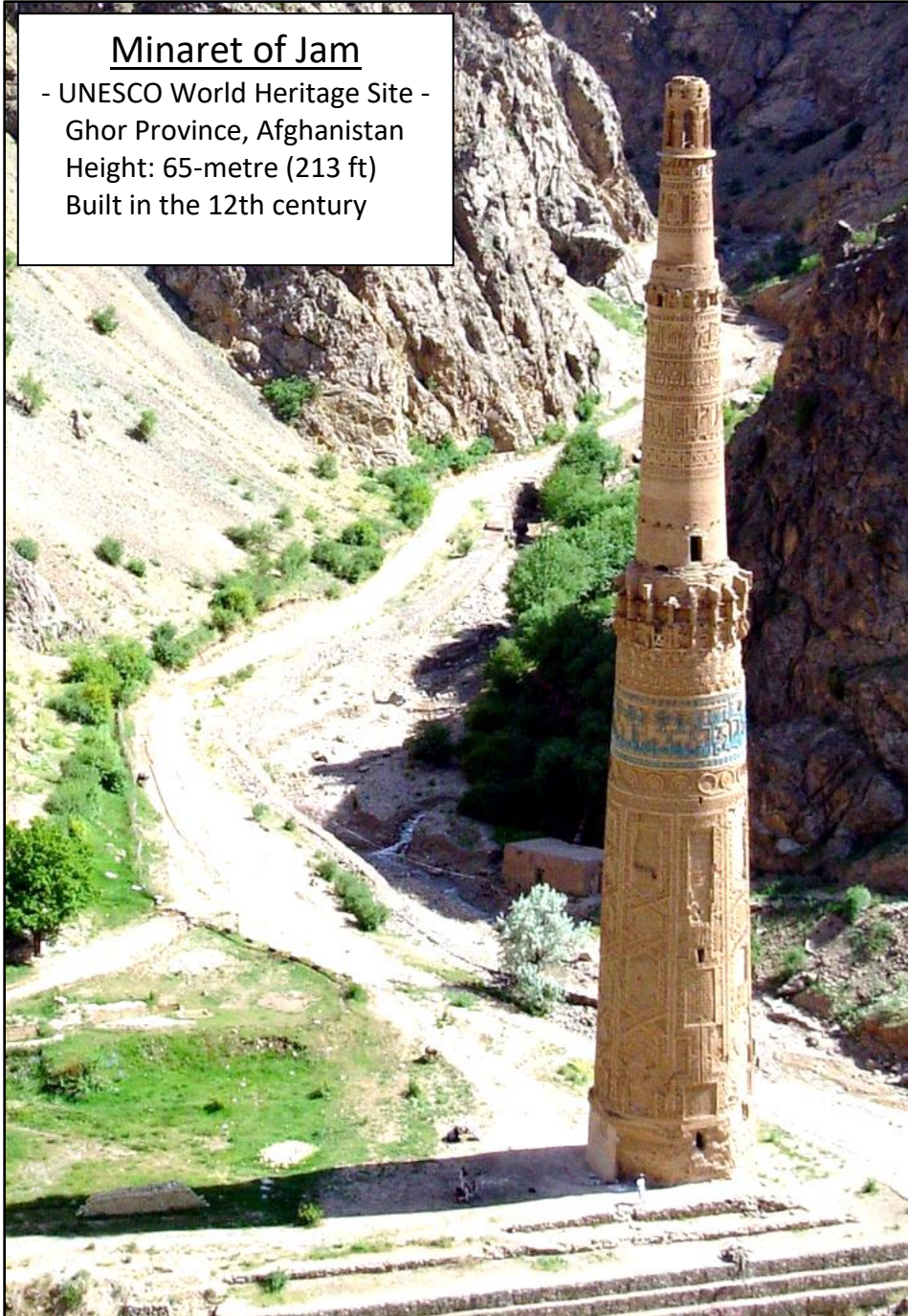


Minaret of Jam
